## Rules \& Regulations:

I. This is a scratch tournament open to all bowlers, male and female, including youth who are current members of USBC. Entry includes all members of all professional bowling organizations. Bowlers may purchase USBC membership at Tenpins \& More. Youth bowlers must sign a USBC Prize Waiver Form prior to the start of competition and designate to take their prize in the form of a youth scholarship. Entry Fee is $\$ 300$ (or $\$ 315$ if paying by credit card).
2. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the general playing rules and regulations of the USBC and will be certified.
3. Your first squad preference is confirmed with your $\$ 100$ paid deposit, unless you receive an email telling you that squad is already full. Entries will be accepted until Squad 5 starts on Saturday, August 17, 2024, provided lanes are available. Re-entries are not allowed.
4. As bowlers arrive at Tenpins \& More, they will be required to check-in and pay any outstanding entry fees. Qualifying squads will commence as scheduled; any bowler not present will forfeit missed frames, unless a prior squad change has been arranged and confirmed by the tournament director.
5. The 32 finalists will be decided over 8 games bowled across 16 lanes.
6. The 32 finalists will compete in double elimination bracket matches over two-game total pinfall sets in winner's bracket and one-game matches in loser's bracket. Loser's bracket round one is two games. Ties will be resolved by a 9 th/IOth frame roll-off until the tie is broken until only four bowlers remain in the winners (I) and loser's brackets (3).
7. At this stage they will bowl one-game matches: 4 th vs 3 rd, winner vs 2 nd and the winner vs Ist. Should the top seed lose, there will be a further one-game total pinfall match to determine the tournament winner.
8. Should a tie occur for 32 nd place, a one-game roll-off and, if necessary, a 9th/IOth frame roll-off will be bowled until the tie is broken.
9. Substitutes next in line are allowed in the top 32 and would be replacing a bowler who fails to check-in personally with the director at the appointed time on Sunday, August 18, 2024. Should a bowler be unable to continue, the bowler present must bowl their match unopposed.
10. Any protests affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director before the tournament prize payments are made. The decision of the tournament director will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
II. The top 4 bowlers must wear shirts provided by the tournament director. Personal sponsors logo patches may be displayed on this shirt.
12. All prize money and awards are subject to a field of 192 bowlers entering and will be adjusted according to the number of bowlers. The prize fund portion of each bowler's entry fee is $\$ 195$, which will be returned $100 \%$ to the prize winners, while lineage and expense fees are $\$ 105$. USBC Rule 308 has been followed. (The New Mexico Open prize fund portion of bowler's entry fees of $\$ 37,440$ is easily covered in the total proposed pay-out of more than $\$ 76,000$.)
